RE: 2018-RUI-99 - Ruling Final Outcome

**Security Staff, Todd Jennings**, (currently under summary suspension), was duly notified and waived his rights to a 10 day notice of hearing **on August 3, 2018**, for his extensive criminal history, falsifying his licensing application, and being on probation.

The Board of Stewards hereby revoke any/all New Mexico Racing Commission licenses belonging to **Todd Jennings**, effective immediately **August 3, 2018**. Furthermore, **Todd Jennings** is referred to the New Mexico Racing Commission for their further review prior to any further application. During said time of applicable suspension **Todd Jennings** is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC **per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(a-b) Exclusion**.

**Licensee is found to be in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with:**

**16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(a) GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY MEASURES.** The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant has been convicted of a felony.

**16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(b) GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY MEASURES** The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant has been convicted of violating any law regarding gambling or a controlled dangerous substance.

**16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(d) GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY MEASURES** The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant has failed to disclose or falsely states any information required in the application;

**16.47.1.8 (L) (3) GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY MEASURES** Any license denied, suspended or revoked by the commission pursuant to these rules shall state the time period for the effect of its ruling. When the action is taken for a misdemeanor or felony conviction, the time period shall be the period of the licensee's or applicant's imprisonment; or if not imprisoned, the period of probation, deferral, **unless the person can satisfy the commission of sufficient rehabilitation**. This rule shall also apply to licensees who voluntarily turn in their license because of, or in anticipation of, a conviction.

**16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(i) – CONDUCT** Which states in pertinent part "The Commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures if the applicant is a person whose conduct or reputation may reflect on the honesty, and integrity of horse racing"

**15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(g) STEWARDS AUTHORITY** The stewards may order that a person be ineligible for licensing; or they may deny a license to an applicant on grounds set forth in the act or these rules.

**15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(j) REFER TO THE COMMISSION** The stewards may refer any matter to the commission and may include recommendations for disposition. The absence of a steward's referral shall not preclude commission action in any matter

If the deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the period is extended to include the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday. The appeal must be received by noon, at the main commission offices or with the stewards who issued the ruling and must be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$500. The fee must be in the form of cash, a cashier's check, money order or personal check."
