In reference to rulings RETA2688, RETA2689, RETA2690, RETA2691, and SHRP5093 and in accordance with 16.47.1.8 (L)(1) (e) Reciprocity, the Trainer license issued to JUDD S. KEARL shall remain suspended until he is reinstated by the Texas Racing Commission. Furthermore, JUDD S. KEARL must appear before the New Mexico Board of Stewards prior to any future licensing.

During said time of applicable suspension, JUDD S. KEARL is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21) Exclusion. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of , JUDD S. KEARL are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c) Exclusion.

Licensee is found to be in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with:
