RE: 2018-ZIA-52 - Modified Ruling 15.2.3.8(B)(1)(e) Stewards Authority The stewards shall have the authority to amend, revoke, rescind or modify any ruling that they issued in error in accordance with the laws of this state and these rules **SUSPENSION DATES CORRECTED** 

Jockey ALAN LEGARDA-HERNANDEZ was summoned and appeared before the Board of Stewards October 15, 2018, for careless riding during the running of the 1st race on October 14, 2018, at Zia Park Racetrack, while aboard "PILOTPOINTDASHING". (Bore out under left handed whip.)

The Board of Stewards hereby assess ALAN LEGARDA-HERNANDEZ a suspension of 7 calendar days (October 22, 2018, through October 28, 2018, inclusive). ALAN LEGARDA-**HERNANDEZ** is allowed to ride designated races.

## Licensee is found in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with:

15.2.5.13(E)(2)(a) NMAC: Post to Finish Which states in pertinent part that "A jockey shall not ride carelessly or willfully so as to permit his/her mount to interfere with, impede or intimidate any other horse in the race."

15.2.5.13(E)(3)(d) NMAC: Post to Finish (d) In a straightaway race, every horse must maintain position as nearly as possible in the lane in which it starts. If a horse is ridden, drifts or swerves out of its lane in such a manner that it interferes with, impedes or intimidates another horse, it is a foul and may result in the disqualification of the offending horse.

15.2.5.13(E)(3)(c) NMAC: Post to Finish Which states in pertinent part that "If the Stewards determine the foul was intentional, or due to careless riding, they may fine or suspend the guilty jockey.
