Owner, Eric Hernandez, having been duly notified, failing to appear, and had his hearing held in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d), before the Board of Stewards on October 21, 2017 at Zia Park Racetrack, for failing to disclose criminal/arrest history on his licensing application.

The Board of Stewards hereby issues the immediate suspension of any/all New Mexico Racing Commission licenses belonging to Eric Hernandez (effective immediately October 21, 2017). Furthermore, Eric Hernandez must appear before the New Mexico Racing Commission for their further review prior to any further participation or application.

During said time of suspension Eric Hernandez is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Racing Commission in accordance with 15.2.1.9(C)(21)(a) NMAC.

Licensee is found to be in violation of:
