For this SECOND Class 3B medication violation in a 365- day period issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (L)NMAC, the Board of Stewards assessed Fernando Carrete a penalty as follows.

- 1. A 90 day suspension of all NMRC licenses starting December 29, 2016, through March 29, 2017, inclusive.
- 2. (\$2,000) two thousand dollar fine to paid on or before <u>January 17, 2017</u>, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(7)(f) NMAC and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC: Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.
