Trainer Jesus Rondan Jr. was duly notified and responded telephonically before the Board of Stewards on <u>January 2, 2018</u>, for failing to take possession of claimed horse <u>"MAD MAX"</u> <u>CARTEL"</u> after the running of the 5th race on December 9, 2017, at Zia Park Racetrack.

The Board of Stewards hereby assess <u>Jesus Rondan Jr.</u> a fine in the amount <u>of two hundred dollars</u>, (\$200.00). The fine is to be paid on or before <u>February 2, 2018</u>, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3) (1) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension
