Jockey, Reves Gomez, having been summoned and having appeared before the Board of Stewards on February 15, 2019 for careless riding during the running of the 5th race on February 12, 2019, at Sunland Park Racetrack while aboard "Between the Buoys". (Bore in sharply after the start impeding number 1 causing him to veer in and take up sharply.)

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed Reyes Gomez a suspension of 7 calendar days (February 22, 2019 thru February 28, 2019). Reves Gomez is allowed to ride designated races.

Licensee is found in violation of and written in accordance with:

15.2.5.13(E)(2)(a) NMAC: Post to Finish Which states in pertinent part that "A jockey shall not ride carelessly or willfully so as to permit his/her mount to interfere with, impede or intimidate any other horse in the race."

15.2.5.13(E)(3)(d) NMAC: Post to Finish (d) In a straightaway race, every horse must maintain position as nearly as possible in the lane in which it starts. If a horse is ridden, drifts or swerves out of its lane in such a manner that it interferes with, impedes or intimidates another horse, it is a foul and may result in the disqualification of the offending horse.

Jockey, <u>Alfredo Sigala</u>, having been summoned <u>and having failed to appear or send a</u> <u>representative</u> before the Board of Stewards <u>on February 15, 2019</u> for careless riding during the running of the <u>3rd race on February 15, 2019</u>, <u>at Sunland Park Racetrack</u> while <u>aboard "Sky Harbor"</u>. (Bore in sharply after the start impeding number 4 causing him to check sharply.)

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed <u>Alfredo Sigala</u> a suspension of <u>7 calendar days</u> (<u>February 23, 2019 thru March 1, 2019</u>). <u>Alfredo Sigala</u> is allowed to ride designated races.

Licensee is found in violation of and written in accordance with:

15.2.5.13(E)(2)(a) NMAC: Post to Finish Which states in pertinent part that "A jockey shall not ride carelessly or willfully so as to permit his/her mount to interfere with, impede or intimidate any other horse in the race."

Trainer: Miguel L. Hernandez; having been duly notified and appeared before the Board Of Stewards on February 16, 2019 regarding a lab report from Industrial Laboratories (The official testing laboratory for the NMRC), for a confirmed positive for the drug, Dexamethasone (class 4C-Major penalty) found in test sample <u>E290329</u> taken from the <u>1st place finisher</u> "Officer Griggs" following the 6th race, on October 1, 2018, at the Zia Park Race Track.

The original lab report indicated a finding of Dexamethasone at 37.8 +/- 2.4 pg/ml in the blood, the allowable limit for Dexamethasone is 5 pg/ml in the blood (15.2.6.9 Attachment 2 Page 3). Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to trainer, and confirmed by TVMDL.

Judge Lanier Racing (Tom R. McKenna) is the owner of record for horse "Officer Griggs"

For Miguel L. Hernandez's FIRST Class 4C-Major medication violation, in a 365-day period, issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(4), the Board of Stewards assessed a penalty as follows:

1. A (\$1,000) One thousand dollar fine to paid on or before March 18, 2019, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(I) NMAC. Failure to pay fine in prescribed time will result in an immediate suspension.

Owner Tom R. McKenna (Judge Lanier Racing) was duly notified, and appeared before the Board of Stewards on February 16, 2019. The hearing was in regard to a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug **Dexamethasone (class 4C major)**, found in test sample **#E290329**. The test sample was taken from the first place finisher "Officer Griggs" following the 6th race on October 1, 2018 at Zia Park Racetrack.

The certificate of analysis from Industrial Laboratories (official testing laboratory for the NMRC) indicated a finding of Dexamethasone at 37.8 +/- 2.4 pg/ml in the blood. Which exceeds the limit of 5.0 pg/ml

A split sample was sent by the trainer and confirmed at (9 +/- 2 pg/ml) TVMDL.

Miguel L. Hernandez is the trainer of record for the horse "Officer Griggs".

In accordance with 15.2.6.9(B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS, this is Tom R. McKenna's (Judge Lanier Racing) FIRST Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365-day period. The Board of Stewards hereby assess penalty as follows:

> 1. The horse "Officer Griggs" is hereby disqualified from first place and ordered unplaced from the 6th race on October 1, 2018 at Zia Park Racetrack for all but pari-mutuel wagering.

2. The horse "Officer Griggs" must pass a commission-approved examination before being eligible to run.
