Groom and Exercise Rider, LUIS ALBERTO OCASIO JR., was summarily suspended on February 10, 2018, and waived his rights to a 10 day notice of hearing before the Board of Stewards on March 4, 2018. LUIS ALBERTO OCASIO JR. tested positive for amphetamine and methamphetamine during a drug screening on February 10, 2018.

The Board of Stewards hereby issue LUIS ALBERTO OCASIO JR. penalty of the following: 1. A suspension of all NMRC licenses for 60 days (retroactive from the summary suspension instated on February 10, 2018) February 10, 2018, through April 10, 2018, inclusive.

Per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(a-b) NMAC, LUIS ALBERTO OCASIO JR. is hereby excluded from all areas

RE: 2018-SUN-151 - Modified Ruling15.2.3.8(B)(1)(e) Stewards Authority The stewards shall have the authority to amend, revoke, rescind or modify any ruling that they issued in error in accordance with the laws of this state and these rules. **SUSPENSION DATES CORRECTED**

Owner/Authorized Agent/Trainer Justin Evans was duly notified and represented telephonically by his attorney Gene Chavez before the Board of Stewards on March 9, 2018, for a hearing that was continued at the request of Gene Chavez from February 10, 2018 to February 25, 2018 and then continued again to March 9, 2018. The hearing was in regard to a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug Dexamethasone (class 4 penalty category C MAJOR drug), found in test sample NM30226. The test sample was taken from the first place finisher "Dapirate" following the 8th race on November 26, 2017, at Zia Park Racetrack in Hobbs, NM.

The affidavit from UC/Davis (official testing laboratory for the NMRC) indicated a finding of Dexamethasone at 47 pg/ml in the blood, the allowable limit for Dexamethasone is 5 pg/ml in the blood (15.2.6.9 Attachment 2 Page 3). Dexamethasone was confirmed at 59.1±3.1 pg/ml in the blood of the split sample sent to Industrial Laboratories on January 4, 2018.

Larry Nichols, Denise Nichols, and Ms. Winifred Vick (trustee Robert Vick), the owners of record for horse "Dapirate", were duly notified for a hearing on February 25, 2018. Denise Nichols, failed to appear, and had her hearing held in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d)nonappearance. Larry Nichols and Ms. Winifred Vick (trustee Robert Vick) waived their rights to a formal hearing. This is their first Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365 day period, in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS

For Justin Evans's THIRD Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365 day period, issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS, the Board of Stewards hereby assess penalty as follows:

1. A (\$2,500) two thousand and five hundred dollar fine to paid on or before April 10, 2018, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(1) NMAC. Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.

2. A 30 day suspension of all NMRC licenses starting March 14, 2018, through April 12, 2018, inclusive.

15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) Medication and Prohibited Substances - Procedures shall be established to ensure that a licensed trainer is not able to benefit financially during the period for which the individual has been suspended. This includes, but is not limited to, ensuring that horses are not transferred to a licensed person within the first degree of affinity (marriage relationship) or first degree of consanguinity (blood relationship): (a) first degree of affinity shall mean the licensee's spouse or spouse's mother, father, brother, sister, son or daughter; (b) first degree of consanguinity shall mean the licensee's mother, father, brother, sister, son or daughter

During said time of applicable suspension Justin Evans is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21). Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of Justin Evans are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c). Licensee is found to be in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with 15.2.3.8(B)(1)(3)(f)(g)(j)Stewards /15.2.6.9(C)(4) Medication Restrictions/15.2.6.11 Trainer
