Trainer Mario Fernandez was duly notified and responded telephonically for a hearing before the Board of Stewards on October 21, 2018. The hearing was in regard to a certificate of analysis from Industrial Laboratories (official testing laboratory for the NMRC) for a confirmed positive for the prohibited (class 3 penalty B) drug "clenbuterol" detected in the blood of horse "Caesar Germanicus" (Test Sample #: E276332), who finished THIRD place in the 9th race on July 6, 2018, at Albuquerque Downs Racetrack. On September 20, 2018 clenbuterol was confirmed in the urine of the split sample sent to TVMDL.

Carlos F. Paez, the owner of record for horse "Caesar Germanicus", was duly notified and failed to appear for this hearing. This is Carlos F. Paez's FIRST Class 3B medication violation in a 365-day period.

MIDIGATING CIRCUMSTANCES: CLENBUTEROL WAS DETECTED IN THE BLOOD AT A LEVEL OF 1.2 PG/ML AND CONFIRMED IN THE SPLIT SAMPLE AT A LEVEL OF 1.1±.06 PG/ML.

For Mario Fernandez's FIRST Class 3B medication violation in a 365-day period, the Board of Stewards hereby assess a penalty, issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(2) Penalty Recommendations, as follows:
