During said time of suspension <u>Alejandro Lopez</u> is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Racing Commission in accordance with 15.2.1.9(C) (21) (a) NMAC.

Licensee is found to be in violation of:

15.2.1.9(B) (4) (d) Nonappearance of a summoned party after adequate notice shall be construed as a waiver of the right to a hearing before the stewards. The stewards may suspend the license of a person who fails to appear at a disciplinary hearing after written notice of the hearing has been sent, in compliance with this subsection.
