		The NM Racing Commission heard arguments from both parties and reviewed the video several times of race #6 that ran on August 13, 2023, at Ruidoso Downs. Pursuant to Rule 15.2.5.13(E)(3)(a) NMAC states: 3) Maintaining a straight course. (a) When the way is clear in a race, a horse may be ridden to any part of the course, but if any horse swerves, or is ridden to either side, so as to interfere with, impede or intimidate any other horse, it is a foul. The Board of Stewards found that horse #4, "Fearless Moon", placed first (1st). The Ruidoso Downs Board of Stewards ruled horse #4, "Fearless Moon", intimated/impeded and altered the course of horse #5 and therefore, disqualified horse #1, "Fearless Moon" and placed him from first place to sixth place. Mr. Stinebaugh also had the opportunity to present his evidence and argument regarding the ruling of the Ruidoso Downs Board of Stewards that day. Mr. Stinebaugh called GR Carter as an "expert" witness. Ruidoso Downs State Steward Jason Hart also testified. If the interference causes a placing, the Stewards are tasked to make the call and be fair. The photos show how close they were to clipping heels.	passed unanimously by roll call vote.
