Jockey, Jacob Enriquez having been summoned and having appeared before the Zia Park Board of Stewards, on November 24, 2024, for careless riding during the running of the 6th race on November 23, 2024, at Zia Park while aboard # 6 "Eyofthecard" who veered out sharply into #'s 7 & 8 practically causing the #8 horse to unseat its rider and costing an opportunity for a better placing. #6 "Eyofthecard" was disqualified from 3rd to 8th place.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards issued the following penalty:

A 7-calendar day suspension, beginning on December 2, 2024, through September 8, 2024. Mr. Jacob Enriquez may ride designated races.
